

# COMMUNITY BULLETIN BOARDS

## RULES FOR USE

The purpose of the community bulletin boards is to allow for informal communications between High Knob residents. The glass bulletin boards at the **Clubhouse and gates** will remain as the location for official correspondence for HKOAI and HKUI.

1. Posting materials on High Knob community bulletin boards is limited to **High Knob owners only** and is free of charge.  
**Materials posted by outside parties will be removed immediately.**
2. Each posting must include the following information in legible form:
  - a. **DATE OF POSTING**
  - b. **NAME**
  - c. **CONTACT INFORMATION** (Phone Number, e-mail, and/or address)
3. Postings shall be **no larger than 8 ½ X 11 inches**
4. **Items may be posted for 30 days.** After that time, it is the responsibility of the posting party to remove materials.
5. Materials must be **firmly secured** to the board by **staples or tacks** provided by the posting party and **will be removed when materials are removed.**  
Residents are reminded of occasional high winds on our mountain and encouraged to make every effort to not litter the community with your notices.
6. **Residents are encouraged to post materials that are friendly to readers of all ages, which are informative and sensitive to the harmonious community spirit with which these boards are provided.**
7. Community bulletin boards are funded by HKOAI funds. The High Knob Owners' Association Board of Directors reserves the right to immediately remove any postings that are considered discourteous, inappropriate, or otherwise harmful to the best interests of the community. Inappropriate postings shall include, but not be limited to include postings of material for political campaigns for federal, state, local or community elections.
8. If a posting is removed prior to the expiration of 30 days, the person posting the item should be notified.
9. Community bulletin boards are funded by HKOAI funds and the appropriate use of them will be monitored by the High Knob Owners Association Board of Directors and the High Knob office staff.
